

BT LONDON & HOME COUNTIES LOTTERIES RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

INTRODUCTION

The information below outlines the conditions governing the BT London & Home Counties lotteries. Funds that are raised from the lottery will contribute towards the enhancement of recreational activities for BT Employees and BT Pensioners / Associate Members working and living in London & Home Counties.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

The subscriptions are £1 per chance per month and are payable annually in advance (£12 per chance per year). You may have more than one chance by increasing your subscriptions in steps of £1 (ie £2 per month gives you two chances), up to a maximum of ten chances. In accordance with lottery legislation, the funds raised will be divided between prize money, enhancing recreation in London & Home Counties and any administrative costs incurred. The Lottery Associate membership will run from **1 September each year**. Anybody wishing to join the lottery as an Associate member in any other month of the year, will need to submit the appropriate remittance as indicated on the attached application form.

THE DRAW

The draw will take place no later than the 15th day of each month and winners will be notified personally. To qualify for inclusion in each Car Draw, you must have been contributing to the lottery club for a period of three months leading up to and including the month of the draw. The draw for Cars is currently made in February and August each year.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is available to BT employees, BT Pensioners and Ex-employees (headquartered or living throughout the BT London & Home Counties zone). Members will be issued with a membership card, which will indicate their lottery number(s). When you submit your application, we will enter you into the lottery based upon your location ie London (Inside the M25), Home Counties (Outside the M25).

APPLICATION

If you would like to join either of the BTLHCRA lotteries, please complete the form attached and return it with the remittance made payable to **BTLRA** for the appropriate amount to Paul McLean at the address shown, **together with a self addressed envelope**. It is essential that you complete all sections of the application form accurately and return to Paul McLean.

PROMOTERS

The promoter of the London lottery is Chris Wright, Chairman BTLHCRA and the promoter of the Home Counties lottery is Paul McLean, Events Manager BTLHCRA. The lotteries are promoted under the aegis of the BT London & Home Counties Recreation Association.
